**Who should apply?** Anyone with demonstrated skills and experience driving and backing up a trailer. Our primary vehicle & trailer is a king cab pick-up truck with an 8-foot bed and a 16 foot landscape trailer. Do not apply if you cannot backup a trailer.

- Must be able to provide personal transportation to and from 415 Blackberry Valley Rd, Greenville SC 29617
- Must be at least 21 years old and be eligible for employment
- Must be a safe driver with a good driving record eligible to be added to our commercial auto policy
- Experience hooking up and driving trailers
- Ability to pass a driving and trailer skills test that will be administered during an on site interview. This is a pass fail test with instant failures. Must be able to demonstrate each skill to pass.
- Comfortable driving a truck and trailer with a 2500+ pound load
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds on a routine basis
- Must be able to bend and stoop on a continual basis
- Must be able to pass a criminal background test and drug test
- Ability to work quickly and efficiently
- Must be able to work effectively as a member of a team with a positive attitude
- Must be able to perform manual labor outside in all weather conditions
- Must be able to work around ants, bees, thorns, pollens, poison ivy and oak, and environmental risks
- Must comply with TreesUpstate's policies and procedures
