Job Requirements & Skills

- Must be able to provide personal transportation to and from 415 Blackberry Valley Rd, Greenville SC
- Must be at least 18 years old and be eligible for employment
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds on a routine basis
- Must be able to bend and stoop on a continual basis
- Must be able to pass a criminal background test and drug test
- Ability to work quickly and efficiently
- Must be able to work effectively as a member of a team with a positive attitude
- Must be able to perform manual labor outside in all weather conditions
- Must be able to work around ants, bees, thorns, pollens, poison ivy and oak, and environmental risks
- Must comply with all tree planting and tree care standards
- Must comply with TreesUpstate's policies and procedures
- Must present yourself in a professional and appropriate manner

Job Duties & Responsibilities: Tree Care includes and is not limited to:

- Evaluate trees for pest and disease problems
- Provide structural pruning for urban trees and make proper pruning cuts
- Test and amend soils for optimal growing conditions
- Mulch trees, including correcting over-mulching
- Safely operate water trailer and refill water tank from fire hydrants
- Water trees
- The use of hand tools and power tools
- Weeding, mulching, raking, pruning, digging, planting, installing, fertilizing, edging, trimming, mowing
- Stake leaning trees, remove stakes from straight trees

- Exotics removal
- Other as needed
