**About Our Workforce Development Program:** The Workforce Development program was created as part of a growing national environmental justice movement for racial and economic equality. We're improving the lives of residents in low-to-moderate income areas through tree planting, arboriculture, and sustainable careers for young adults (18-31 year-olds) who want to make a noticeable difference in the communities in which they live, work, and play. You will coach up to 4 Tree Care Apprentices at a time and provide them holistic on-the-job training in addition to a wide range of educational, professional development opportunities and practical life skills over the course of their paid 15-24 week program. Your success will be measured by 50% of our apprentices securing long term employment specifically in the tree and landscape field.

## **Compensation:**

\$19-\$22 per hour and/or commensurate with education, professional experience, certifications, and licenses (e.g., CDL, SC Pesticide Applicator, ISA Certified Arborist, TCIA Tree Care Specialist, SC Certified Landscape Professional).

## **Days and Hours:**

Full time. Saturday workdays required during planting season October - March

## **Requirements:**

- Must take a criminal background test
- Must have a valid Driver's License and a clean driving record
- Reliable transportation to work (Greenville, SC)
- Experience hooking up, loading, unloading, securing loads, and driving trailers
- Must be able to perform manual labor outside in all weather conditions, including rain, snow, and 95°F
  heat
- Communication and leadership skills

## Responsibilities:



- Recruit, supervise and mentor a team of 4 apprentice employees as part of TreesUpstate's workforce development program.
- Inspire young adults on issues of tree equity and to pursue a career in the green industry.
- Train or schedule trainings for apprentice employees on work ethic, professionalism, financial empowerment, punctuality, dress code, conflict resolution, and safety.
- Schedule job shadow days or internships for apprentices and provide their transportation using a company vehicle.
- With the help of the Community Forester, train apprentice employees on industry related topics including SC Certified Landscape Professional Curriculum, Pesticide Applicator License, tree planting techniques, tree pruning techniques, tree care, and plant identification.
- Lead and assist with planting programs at parks, schools, neighborhoods, and greenspaces.
- Create and maintain positive relationships in the community and with site partners and volunteers.
